



Preamble

The world is largely divided along the lines drawn by religions. Many wars are fought by believers in this or that religious dogma, their God and the rules & conditions their religious hierarchies impose on not just believers, but the world community. **UNITY** recognizes that religions have the potential to be mired in the delusion and ignorance of their adherents ... ignorance that can only be countered by secular education. That education has to start with the very young. This is the premise of **UNITY**.

UNITY is an alternative to religions. It is a syncretic, secular, yet spiritual belief system which is based on the reality that there is no God ... yet myriad ways of believing in a god-like energy; with one way as valid as any of the others (conditions apply). This notion of a spirituality without God can give us peace. Of those religiously inclined many feel torn between - on the one hand - their faith in a religious God, the being believers personify ... who can be prayed to, who interferes with what happens in the world; and - on the other hand - their often devastating doubt that such a God may be an illusion, in fact a delusion ... since there is - of course - no proof that such a God exists.

UNITY fosters a spiritual belief system that unites all religions. It then follows that none of them have a valid claim to the exclusive 'rightness' of their belief in their God. If an interventionist God existed, why would he create so many competing religions? But this does not mean we cannot believe in a god-like energy; and on that level many beliefs are possible, as long as these conditions are fulfilled: They must be peaceful and tolerant. Religious groups often form the bedrock of supportive, benevolent communities; but followers may quietly have their own personal spiritual belief (without a God), yet remain in their congregation due to the community spirit ... and the theatricality of it all.

UNITY is peace; without doubt; while free of an elusive God.

I believe in tolerance, justice, freedom, pacifism, equality, love; I loathe authoritarianism, indoctrination, control, manipulation.

I believe in keeping an open mind, allowing perceptions (and beliefs) to be changed, and to be uncertain about certainties.

*Jiddu Krishnamurti (1895 ~ 1986) was a free-thinking philosopher, speaker, writer and educator. His supporters work through non-profit foundations with several independent schools, based on Krishnamurti's views on education.

Krishnamurti's subject matters included psychological revolution, the nature of mind, meditation, inquiry, human relationships and bringing about radical change in society. He stressed the need for a revolution in the psyche of every human.
